People experience homelessness if they are living in insecure, overcrowded, dangerous, illegal or very temporary accommodation (e.g. bed and breakfast hotels, women's refuges, hostels, friend's/relative's floors, and squats)

Homeless people with literally nowhere else to go may end up sleeping rough outside.



About NOAH

NOAH (New Opportunities And Horizons) is a Luton-based charity offering hope and support to people struggling against homelessness and exclusion.

There is no quick fix solution to homelessness. People become and stay homeless for a number of reasons and, although an important aspect of our work is finding permanent accommodation, simply putting a roof over someone's head is rarely enough to correct the chain of events that led them into homelessness in the first place.

NOAH works with the whole person to find permanent and individually tailored pathways out of homelessness. Our support is offered to both homeless and severely excluded people at a pace and level suited to each individual.

Our support ranges from a hot meal and medical care to NVQ accredited training and we continue to provide this support long after permanent accommodation has been found.

We are a faith based organisation and our work is motivated by the Christian principles of love and charity. However, we never link charity with evangelism and you do not need to be a Christian to work for, support or receive help from NOAH.

About The Luton Ark

For over 20 years NOAH has carried out its work from a range of well loved, but increasingly obsolete buildings across Luton.

NOAH's vision for the future is a new building with all existing services combined under one roof and new services to fill in the gaps in current provision.

This new building will provide a permanent home for all NOAH's main services as well as offering new services such as supported accommodation. In particular, the building will accommodate those who are currently suffering addiction as well as those in recovery - giving us the opportunity to reach and support more people living in deprivation.
