



Your Legacy

If you are thinking of writing or changing your will you may wish to consider leaving this world a better place by remembering NOAH in your Will. You don't have to be wealthy or make any complicated legal arrangements to leave your legacy and every gift, however modest, really does help.

Ways to Remember NOAH in Your Will

Once you have taken care of those closest to you, there are a few different kinds of gift you can choose to leave in your Will. The most common of these are:

Residuary bequest

A **proportion** of your total estate after all other bequests have been made and debts cleared

Pecuniary bequest

A **set sum** of money

Specific bequest

A **named item** such as a piece of jewellery

Contingent bequest

A gift that is **dependent on an event which may or may not happen** such as a bequest which applies only if other beneficiaries named in the Will die before the testator (person who made the Will)

Information for Your Solicitor

Should you wish to remember NOAH in your Will you might wish to take the following information to your solicitor to ensure that your wishes are accurately followed.

Suggested wording for a pecuniary bequest: "I give to THE NOAH ENTERPRISE (NEW OPPORTUNITIES AND HORIZONS) at 141 Park Street, Luton, Bedfordshire, LU1 3HG (registered charity number 1059672) the sum of £..... (free of all taxes) for its charitable purposes, and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or authorised officer will be sufficient discharge to my executor/s."

Suggested wording for a residuary bequest: "I give% of my residuary estate to THE NOAH ENTERPRISE (NEW OPPORTUNITIES AND HORIZONS) at 141 Park Street, Luton, Bedfordshire, LU1 3HG (registered charity number 1059672) for its charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorised officer will be sufficient discharge to my executor/s."

Suggested standard clause for charitable giving: If at my death any charity named as a beneficiary in this Will or any Codicil hereto has changed its name or amalgamated with or transferred its assets to another body then my Executors shall give effect to any gift made to such charity as if it had been made (in the first case) to the body in its changed name or (in the second place) to the body which results from such amalgamation or to which such transfer has been made.
