



Payroll Giving

Payroll Giving is a simple and tax-free way to support NOAH.

Payroll Giving allows you to make donations directly from your pay. The donations are made after your National Insurance contributions are calculated but before Income Tax is worked out and deducted. Because of this, you only pay tax on what's left. This means that you get tax relief on your donation at your highest rate of tax. For example, a £10 donation to NOAH would cost a basic rate tax payer £8 and a higher rate tax payer just £6.

Information for Your Employer

Payroll Giving lets your employees make donations to charities of their choice directly from their pay – providing they pay tax through PAYE. They can donate as much or as little as they want. You deduct this amount from their pay after working out and deducting their National Insurance contributions, but before applying PAYE.

You pass on all the donations you've deducted to an approved Payroll Giving Agency. They then distribute the donations to your employees' chosen charities - you don't have to do anything else. All modern payroll systems can be set up to handle Payroll Giving and there are no extra tax forms to fill in. Further information can be found at:
